Tom and Marcia Blackwell, proprietors of the Red Bank-based Blackwells' Organic Fruit Sorbetto and Vegan Gelato, will discuss their company's social mission and environmental goals during a program planned from noon to 5 p.m. at the reservoir's environmental center.

The Blackwells will offer samples of their products in exchange for a small donation to Friends of the Parks, a nonprofit organization supporting the efforts of the Monmouth County Park System. The Blackwells' certified organic sorbets and gelatos are made with ingredients obtained from farmers and suppliers dedicated to sustainable agricultural practices, resource conservation and fair trade.
